<u>High Reliability Schools (HRS) Framework/Book Study</u>— Superintendent Hocker explained he would like to wrap up the book study before the end of the school year. Dr. Hocker would like this team to apply what they learned from the book when reviewing the District's strategic plan. He would like the team to spend a few meetings next school year preparing an updated strategic plan and making the plan more in alignment with the HRS framework.

Assistant Superintendent Harris lead the discussion regarding the book study. Team members were asked to read chapters 2, 3, and 4 from Dr. Marzano's book *Leading a High Reliability School*. Chapter 2 focused on a safe, supportive, and collaborative culture. Chapter 3 focused on effective teaching in every classroom. Chapter 4 focused on guaranteed and viable curriculum. Discussion led to connecting the information with the professional learning communities and the District's beliefs, mission and vision statements. Each chapter listed several leading indicators and lagging indicators. Team members had great discussion regarding the material in the chapters.
