I hereby declare that 73.4% of all the qualified voters of the District voting upon the question were in favor of issuing the Bonds. I move to adopt the Resolution Canvassing Returns and Declaring Result of Special Election, as presented."

- **b.** <u>Prairie Rose Elementary Expansion Update</u> Assistant Superintendent Vince Reep will provide updated information regarding the progress towards the expansion at Prairie Rose Elementary. This agenda item is informational only. No action is required.
- c. <u>Student Mobility Report</u> Assistant Superintendent Reep will present student mobility information for students K-12. A copy of his Inward and Outward Migration report, a 5-year summary, and comments are posted under Supporting Documents on the school board website. This agenda item is informational only. No action is requested.
- d. Superintendent's Formative Evaluation DPS will use the same process as last year. President Fehr and Superintendent Sullivan have selected three areas from the superintendent's job description to be evaluated. The areas are: supervision with licensed and non-licensed staff, identification and implementation of board policy needs, effective records management, and supervision of building and grounds, transportation, and student safety. A copy of the superintendent's job description is posted under Supporting Documents. Superintendent Sullivan will respond to the topics in writing and forward the evaluation to the school board members for their comments. Board members are asked to return the evaluation forms to President Fehr by November 22. The written feedback and comments from the board members will be the basis of the evaluation. The legal deadline for completion of the process is December 15. The board will review the evaluation at its December 8 board meeting. This agenda item is informational only. No action is requested.
- e. <u>2014 North Dakota School Boards Association (NDSBA) Resolutions</u> Recent developments in a proposed resolution change require discussion by school board members. Posted under Supporting Documents is information regarding the resolution to change TFFR funding. The resolutions will be voted on by the delegates at the NDSBA fall conference. This agenda item is for discussion only. No action is requested.
- **f.** School Board Workshop There will be a board workshop following the meeting today. We will have a light meal between the school board meeting and the board workshop. No decisions will be made during the workshop, but topics discussed may become future board meeting agenda items. This agenda item is informational only. No action is requested.
- **g.** <u>School Board Policy Revision, First Reading</u> NDSBA has recommended revisions for policy DBBA-Drug and Alcohol Testing for Employees. The change would clarify those in a safety-sensitive position. A copy of the revised policy is posted on the website under Supporting Documents. Administrative recommendation is to revise policy DBBA.
