- e. <u>Superintendent's Formative Evaluation</u> –In 2016, Dickinson Public Schools implemented an online superintendent's evaluation. All Board members submitted their input online before November 9. Board Policy CAAB states "The evaluation instrument shall require Board members to rate the superintendent's performance as either satisfactory or unsatisfactory in each area of the performance identified in the job description." Following are the six areas of performance in the evaluation system:

  - Board Relations
  - Human Resource Management
  - Curriculum and Student Support Services
  - Community Relations
  - Operations and Resources Management
