- g. <u>Early Resignation Incentive Applications</u> Mrs. Marilyn Dukart and Mrs. Susan Bogner, both third grade instructors at Roosevelt Elementary, have submitted their resignation to receive the early resignation incentive. Their resignations are effective 05/28/2018. Mrs. Dukart has been an instructor in the District for the past 18 years. Mrs. Bogner has been an instructor in the District for the past 27 years. The administration will evaluate these vacancies and post any openings at a later date. The administrative recommendation is to approve the early resignation incentive applications.
