

Student Organizations

Occasionally an activity/organization must be added or deleted from the school's activity program. The following criteria may be utilized by the school administration to guide the decision about adding or deleting a school activity/organization.

- Student(s) requesting a new organization will be required to identify and explain the purpose for the proposed organization.
- Student(s) requesting a new organization shall provide a timeline and plan for implementation.
- The administration will evaluate the level of anticipated student participation. There should be sufficient student interest to guarantee the student organization is viable.
- Adequate facilities must be available to accommodate the activity.
- All activities/clubs need to have an advisor/coach recognized by the school.
- The building administrator will determine if there will be an additional cost to the school district.
- Participation in clubs shall be provided in a non-discriminatory manner and will be open to all students in the respective building.
- Student organizations may establish academic qualifications for membership where necessarily related to the purposes of the organization.
- A proposed organization shall not create the potential for disruption of the school or its operation.
- The Dickinson Public Schools and/or building administration reserves the right to determine time and site of the organization's meetings.
- The building principals will periodically review the student organizations offered in the building. Principals will assess the level of student participation and whether the student organization is sustainable by the school district.
- No club will be organized without the approval of the building principal.
