Taylor Places First in the Nation

Taylor Kraenzel placed first in the nation in the Graphic Design Challenge at

the National Technology Competition. *"This is the first time that we have had a student from Dickinson place first in the nation"* reported Erv VanVeldhuizen, technology teacher at Hagen.

His project involved designing a logo for next year's National Convention which will be held in Denver, Colorado. Taylor designed the logo using a program called Composer. Taylor said, *"It was pretty cool. There were over 3,000 kids from all over the world competing at the convention, even Australia and England."*

Taylor is currently a freshman at Dickinson High School. He is the son of Chad and Rhonda Kraenzel.

Twenty-four students from DHS and Hagen qualified to compete at the National TSA Convention this year. The Technology Student Association advisors are Erv VanVeldhuizen (Hagen) and Susan Haider (DHS).
