

ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATIONS
FOR DISTRIBUTION OF LITERATURE

General Guidelines

1. Literature should not be distributed on the school grounds unless it has been approved by the principal.
2. As the maturity of the audience increases, the system should become less restrictive.

Audiences

- a. K-6 students
 - b. 7-8 students
 - c. 9-12 students
 - d. Employees
3. The principal should decide how the child will benefit from the distribution of the literature. The judgment of the building principal is final.
 4. Commercial interest: The school system should be more open to local businesses and more restrictive to nonresident businesses. The promotion must be judged by the principal to be in the best interest of the student.
 5. Local service clubs sponsor and support several excellent programs in the Dickinson Public School District. Building principals are expected to use good judgment when making decisions regarding the distribution of literature to students.
