<p>50% shall be dedicated to bonded indebtedness, property tax reduction, and infrastructure (streets, water, and sewer)</p> <p>30% shall be dedicated to capital improvements to enhance social and economic vitality of Dickinson and the Southwest area</p> <p>20% shall be dedicated to job creation and senior citizen activities</p> <p>(City Ordinance)</p>	<p>Construction of a public building (community center) to be used for the purpose of an aquatic center, gymnasium and related uses</p> <p>Operation, maintenance and repair expenses for community center</p> <p>Property tax reduction and infrastructure (streets, water and sewer)</p> <p>(City Ordinance)</p>	<p>Deposit all proceeds in the City Visitors' Promotion Fund.</p> <p>Must be used generally to promote, encourage, and attract visitors to come to the city, and use the travel and tourism facilities within the city</p> <p>(ND Century Code)</p>	<p>Deposit all proceeds in the City Visitor's Promotion Capital Construction Fund.</p> <p>Must be used generally for tourism or the purchase, equipping, improving, construction, maintenance, repair, and acquisition of buildings or property consistent with visitor attraction or promotion</p> <p>A portion not exceeding 25% of total revenues are dedicated to support of Dickinson visitor attraction through a grant program to special projects and programs. The grant program will be established by the visitor's committee, which will also oversee the program and recommend grant awards to the City Commission.</p> <p>(ND Century Code) (City Ordinance)</p>
