Instructions for New Teachers in the Classroom

Tri Energy Cooperative (Cenex) recently donated \$37,000 to the DPS Foundation to be used to support teachers in the classroom through their Gallons of Gratitude Program. The Dickinson Public Schools Foundation will be using leftover dollars from last year's program to help new teachers in the classroom.

Instructions for New Classroom Teachers (Certified Staff)

- 1) New classroom teachers (certified staff) can order or be reimbursed for up to \$105 of classroom materials plus an additional \$120 of classroom materials (\$225 total). Purchases must not exceed \$225. You will not be reimbursed for more than \$225.
- Purchases You can choose to be reimbursed for classroom materials you have purchased, order materials using your building's PCard, or by following your building's purchase order process. Please work with your building secretary to order or be reimbursed. Purchases must be made from July 1, 2023, through December 15, 2023. To get reimbursed, fill out a District Check Reimbursement form and submit it to your building secretary along with your receipts. Receipts are required for all reimbursements. Do not send the check reimbursement form to the DPS Foundation. Please submit for reimbursement one time in order minimize paperwork.
- 3) **Deadline** All purchases must be completed and submitted for payment by **December 15, 2023. Don't miss out on this amazing opportunity!!!**
- 4) Impact Form & Thank You Teachers will be required to complete an Impact form and a Thank you note to Tri Energy Cooperative. The forms will be posted on the Foundation's website and are attached. Pictures and videos are helpful. Tri Energy Cooperative has requested feedback on the impact their generous donation has made. We share what is purchased, comments, pictures, videos, etc. We want to make sure that they continue this great program.
