


Prairie Rose Hosts “Leader in Me” Community Day

The Leader in Me program teaches leadership and life skills to empower children inside and outside of school. Every child is recognized a capable leader. The program helps teach elementary children the 7 Habits of Happy Kids to use in school, at home, and in their everyday lives. The habits include “Be proactive” teaching children they are in charge of themselves and their actions, “Put first things first” teaching them how to focus and prioritize, and “Seek first to understand, then to be understood” which teaches children how to listen before they speak and to consider other peoples’ perspectives.

The Foundation funded professional development as Prairie Rose began exploring the Leader in Me Program. School leaders attended two national training conferences to learn more and see first-hand implementation of the program. Prairie Rose is currently working toward the status of a “Lighthouse School.”
