USE OF VIDEO CAMERAS ON SCHOOL BUSES REGULATIONS

Video surveillance may occur on any school transportation vehicle. The District shall comply with all applicable state and federal laws related to video recordings and record dissemination. The District shall comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and protect student confidentiality as necessary.

The video may only be viewed by those individuals with a legitimate purpose as a result of a reported incident. Only District administrators shall have the authority to approve viewing of transportation recordings when necessary. Video surveillance during a school-sponsored trip, such as an athletic event, may also be accessible to the sponsor or coach of the activity with the consent of the building administrator or Activities Director.

The contents of the videos may be used as evidence in an employee or student disciplinary proceeding. The District may provide the video to law enforcement if the District suspects that a crime has been committed.

Students and employees are prohibited from tampering with the video cameras on school transportation. Students and employees found in violation of this policy will be disciplined in accordance with school district policies and may be required to reimburse the school district for any repairs or replacement necessary as a result of the tampering. In the administration's discretion, matters involving tampering with a school district video camera may be turned over to law enforcement.
