FAFSA - Free Application for Federal Student Aid

Available online October 1, 2022. Parents, guardians and students may use their federal income tax returns from 2021 if applying before January 1. Income will interface on FAFSA after 2022 taxes are completed. Make sure that you use the

website <u>fafsa.ed.gov</u> on our Counselors Corner to ensure that you do not have to pay a fee for your online application and to apply for your FSA (Federal Student Aid) ID number, which will be your online application signature.

***All Students - North Dakota State Scholarship ***

The \$6,000.00 scholarship is available to students at approved colleges and universities in the state of North Dakota. Students may use the ND Scholarship at \$1500.00 per year, or \$750.00 per semester, over six years. Students may defer the scholarship for a variety of reasons.



Bank of ND Dual Credit:

Bank of North Dakota (BND) is accepting applications from eligible students for financial assistance to pay for dual credit courses. Funding may be limited. Applications will be considered by date submitted. Approved students may receive assistance for up to two (2) courses per academic school year. Please see a counselor with questions and/or to get signed up.©

JUNIORS/SOPHOMORES-The PSAT (Pre-SAT)

This is an optional upper academic test that measures reading, writing and language, and math skills for sophomores-juniors. We will test the entire morning of Wednesday, Oct. 12, in the DHS auditorium. Those juniors whose scores are in the very top percentages may also compete for National Merit Scholarships. Counselors will help students with the test interpretation when results are ready.

NCAA Eligibility Center-- Checks academic eligibility for students who want to play sports at a Division I or Division II college/university. Make sure that you have completed your online NCAA application and that you have your official transcript sent from the front office both at the time that you complete your application and at the end of the school year.
