Fifty-three students from four agriculture education classes participate in “Hands-On” learning through real-life experience in sheep management and small animal care.

The Intro to Agriculture class learned how to halter, lead a sheep, and trim hooves. In addition, the Animal Science and Veterinary Science classes also learned how to load and unload from a stock trailer, how to trim hooves, and how to deworm a sheep using a drench gun. The most difficult part of the lab was “spinning” the Ewe’s onto their docks. The lab was at the Dickinson state university indoor arena this past month. A fourth class, Small Animal care, learned how to care for orphan kittens by feeding and grooming during their cat unit of small animals. This lab was at the High School.
