## A Schoolwide Title I Program

- uses Title I funds to upgrade the entire educational program of the school with the goal of raising academic achievement for all students
- is built on schoolwide reform strategies
- is the responsibility of ALL teachers at the school
- ❖ is building-based to meet the needs of the school's students
- ❖ is a model for utilizing Title I funds to meet the needs of all students, including the educationally disadvantaged

# **Schoolwide Plan Components**

- Comprehensive Needs Assessment of the entire school based on information that includes the performance of children in relation to the state academic content and achievement standards.
  - School Improvement Camp (student data/notebooks, PLCs, Kagan Training)
- School Reform Strategies that provide opportunities for all children, including subgroups of students, to address school needs; use methods and instructional strategies that strengthen the academic program, increase amount and quality of learning time, and provide an enriched and accelerated curriculum; and address the needs of all children in the school, particularly the needs of those at risk of not meeting the challenging state academic standards.
