Student Placement for 2024-2025

The assigning of students for the 2024-2025 school year will be done in April. We take a great deal of time in assigning students to the appropriate classrooms. We consider the needs of the students and decide where students need to be placed based on their learning styles and the teaching styles of teachers. We do try to honor parent requests as much as possible, but sometimes that is not always possible. If you have a request for a particular teacher, you must make that request in writing. Please list your child's name, the teacher you would like, and the reason for making that request.

To be considered, all teacher requests need to be turned into Mr. Mack by no later than Friday, March 29th.



Be On Time for School

Daylight Savings Time occurs on Sunday, March 10th, 2024. This means that you will need to spring ahead and turn your clocks forward one hour, so you are not late for school.

NORTH DAKOTA STATE ASSESSMENTS

NDSA will begin Monday, March 11th and will run until May 3rd. Third and fifth graders will be taking the assessment for Reading, Writing and Math. Fourth graders are testing in Math, Reading, Writing and Science. The assessment will be taken on the computer. It will measure school and district progress. Students will be given an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the tools needed to navigate the test. Your child's teacher will let you know when their specific grade levels will be testing. Attendance on these days, as is with any day, is very important.

Peanut/Tree Nut FREE School



Roosevelt Elementary is a Peanut/Tree Nut free school. There are several students at Roosevelt who have food allergies to peanuts/nuts. Therefore, it is important to have strict avoidance of this food to prevent a life-threatening allergic reaction. Any exposure to peanuts/nuts may cause a life-threatening emergency that requires medical treatment. To reduce the chance of this occurring, **we are asking that you or your child do not bring any peanut or nut containing products to school OR any baked items from home.** If your child has eaten peanuts/nuts before coming to school, please be sure your child's hands and face have been thoroughly washed before entering school.
