NORTH DAKOTA STATE ASSESSMENTS

NDSA will begin Monday, March 11th and will run until May 3rd. Third and fifth graders will be taking the assessment for Reading, Writing and Math. Fourth graders are testing in Math, Reading, Writing and Science. The assessment will be taken on the computer. It will measure school and district progress. Students will be given an opportunity to familiarize themselves with the tools needed to navigate the test. Your child's teacher will let you know when their specific grade levels will be testing. Attendance on these days, as is with any day, is very important.


