• <u>Distance Learning to Continue through the End of the Year:</u>

Governor Burgum has extended the mandatory closures to instruction for K-12 public education through the end of the school year. The last day for new assignments will be May 15. Schools will use the following week to assist students and organize device return and personal belongings pickup.

• Graduation Update:

Thanks to our partners at Dickinson State University, we are excited to announce that we will be holding the 2020 graduation ceremony at the Henry Biesiot Activities Center on May 24. We will be releasing more details and information next week.

• Regional After School Program (RASP):

It is our intent to provide the RASP program to our patrons this summer if permitted. We are waiting for clear direction from the Governor/Department of Public Instruction to determine what type of summer programing we will be able to offer. For now, we are now conducting online preregistration for those who plan to participate. Summer School:

We are planning to start summer school in person on July 20. If we are not allowed to have students at school, we will offer summer school through distance learning. We will continue to provide updates on this as they develop.
